

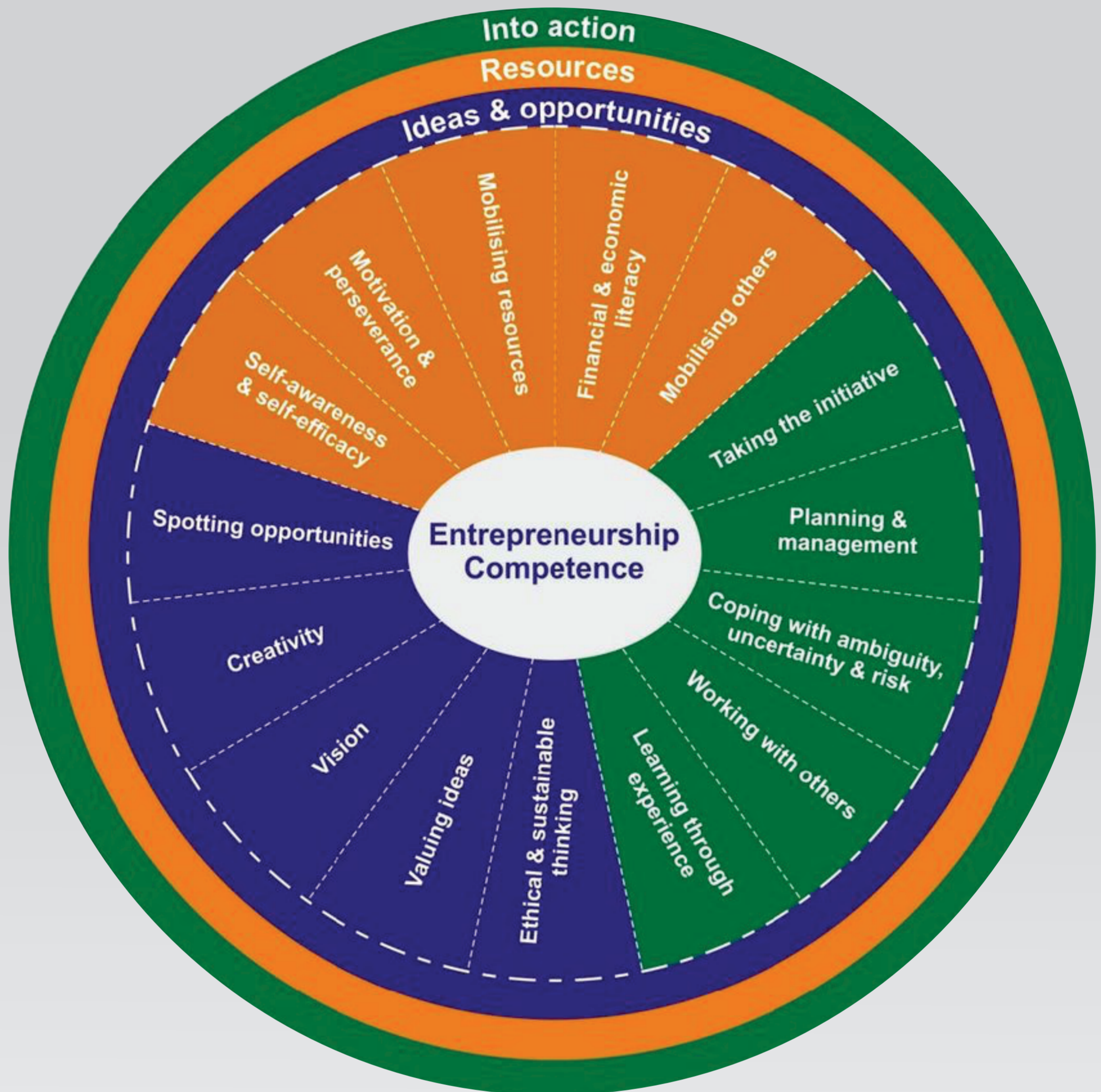
TEACHER AS A KEY TO ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION
